- C. Adoration
- D. Thanksgiving
- E. Commission  
(sending forth—going into the week with purpose)

1. What do these words mean to you? Does the order in which they are placed hold any significance for you?

2. The aim of our Sunday morning gathering is “To Worship God Together.” Discuss the significance of the word “together” in this purpose. Assuming our worship is focused on God, what elements of it do you believe can promote that sense of “togetherness” and community? What ideas does your small group have for acknowledging the community aspect of our worship and encouraging one another in our gatherings?

3. How might this discussion affect your spiritual times with your family at home. Do you believe it is important to structure intentional times of “worship together” into your daily family life? What are ways you have done this, or would consider doing this? What sort of resources could help you make this a regular part of your family life?
