## Growth Group Questions

1. How would you define the “Kingdom of God”?
2. Christ’s Millennial reign will involve a utopian world. What will that utopian world look like? What aspects of this coming utopian world are you looking forward to the most?
3. Are there aspects of or practices in your life that are not under Christ’s reign now? What inconsistencies might this point out between your beliefs and practice...head knowledge vs. heart knowledge?
4. Do you act differently at church then at home? What insight might I Cor. 11:31-32 give us in this matter? How might we experience God’s grace [forgiveness as well as POWER] in these aspects or practices? See Romans 15:13; I Cor. 4:20; II Cor. 4:7, 12:9... for example. Are you willing to be held accountable by a trusted brother or sister to help you gain victory?
5. Just to be clear, what is the difference between the wedding super of the Lamb (Rev. 19:9) and the great supper of God (Rev. 19: 17)?
6. Do you feel it is appropriate for heaven to rejoice at the coming judgment of Satan and those who have not trusted Christ as their Savior? (cf. Rev. 19: 1-6) Explain your answer.
7. In Revelation 19: 1-6 what is the contextual meaning of the word “Hallelujah”? [Remember the Old Testament and New Testament context of the word “hallelujah” has to do with the deliverance of God’s people as the wicked are judged. [cf. Ps. 104: 35. The words translated “praise the Lord” are literally from the word “hallelujah” in the original language.]
8. Define the following (perhaps pointing out their differences): Hades, the Abyss, and the Lake of Fire.
9. Do you understand the concept of “the total depravity of man”? How does this affect a statement like, “I believe that all human beings are basically good at heart”? Given Jeremiah 17:9, would it be possible to have a utopian world apart from Christ?
10. What impact does the reality of the Great White Throne judgment have on you? How might its reality affect your sharing the Gospel? Is the reality of the Great White Throne judgment the best motivation for sharing the Gospel? Why or why not?
