Growth Group Questions

1. What attributes/abilities of Jesus are revealed in Rev. 3:7-13? Why do you think Jesus chose to reveal Himself this way to these people? What impact do these attributes/abilities have on you today?
2. Share with your small group a "trial" you have endured. Would you describe your conduct during that trial as one of 'patient endurance'? If "yes" what resource(s) did you draw on? If "no" what benefit was derived from your impatience? If someone in your small group is in a time of "trial" now, take time to pray for them.
3. How does God's vengeance give you peace? How does God's vengeance give you "pause"?
4. Research and discuss the major theological views on "when" the Rapture will occur (pre-trib, mid-trib, post-trib; pre-wrath). What is the Biblical way to treat those who disagree with your view point?
5. Jesus told the Philadelphian Christians they would be "pillars" in God's temple. Why is this significant OR what does this mean? How can you use this information to bring encouragement to other followers of Jesus?
6. Anyone in your group feel like they are just barely hanging on? If not, do they know someone in this situation? Take the time to read the following verses aloud (Matt. 11:28; Heb. 12:3; Gal. 6:9), sharing how they help you or another person in tough times. As a group, see if you can, this week plan a way to encourage someone who is just barely "hanging in there".
