

BOARD OF DEACONS MEETING

MINUTES, MARCH 1, 2010

II. OPENING: John led the devotional and prayer to open the meeting.

III. WORK DAY STATUS: Don asked for recommendations of additional work projects and possible leads for the projects. Sign ups for the work day will begin Sunday, April 11, in the foyer. The charter school is making plans to clean the school's area on the work day, May 1.

IV. SHED CLEAN UP: Equipment for mens' ministry has been re-located off site. The permit process will make it very costly to remodel the shed as previously discussed.

V. SPRINKLER STATUS: Greg estimates the cost of pipe and fittings to be about \$250. The exact location of the trench that is necessary will be determined after the ground dries out.

VI. BRIDGE STATUS: Questions still remain on the application of the water- sealing material and who will actually do the work.

VII. SANCTUARY LIGHTING: There was agreement that one of the sanctuary stage lights should be redirected to better illuminate the white roses that are placed on the stage each Sunday.

VIII. CHURCH FINANCES: Jim briefly discussed the present conditions of the church's finances.

IX. FOLLOW UP TO RECENT BREAK-IN: Jim informed the members that the equipment recently taken from two pastors' offices has been recovered. In fact, he expressed the hope that good will come of the theft, for new relationships have developed with the management of the mobile home park next door.
