## Angels and Demons Part 4

### Three Battle Grounds

#### I. The **mind**.

- A. What you **think** is what you **are**. (Prov. 23:7a)
- B. There are three possible sources of thoughts that enter our minds:
  1. **Ourselves**. (II Cor. 10:3-5; Eph. 3:20)
  2. **God**. (I Kgs. 19:12)
  3. **Satan**. (Jam. 4:7; Matt. 16:23; Acts 5:3)

#### II. The **heart**. (Prov. 4:23)

- A. For our purposes, the heart refers to our **attitudes** and **emotions**.
- B. The following three attributes are antidotes to pride, unbelief and fear:
  1. **Humility**. (Prov. 22:4; I Pet. 5:6)
  2. **Faith in God**. (Heb. 6:12)
  3. **Trust in God**. (Prov. 3:5-8)

#### III. The **mouth**.

- A. Words are **powerful**. (Prov. 18:21a; cf. Ps. 141:3)
- B. Words can **bless** or **curse**.  
(Jam. 3:10; Matt. 15:18; Num. 13: 30-33)
